Dear Parents/Carers,

On Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> March it is World Book Day 2025. Nursery pupils will be taking part in a World Book Week starting Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> March and ending Friday 7<sup>th</sup> March.

This is a worldwide celebration of reading, books, authors and illustrators. A key aim of World Book Day is to give every child in the UK and Ireland a book of their own to keep, by distributing World Book Day Tokens to children. Children can exchange this token for one of eight exclusive World Book Day Books at participating booksellers.

Reading is the biggest indicator to a child succeeding in the future.
